#### Message from our Grant Consultants

"We appreciate the opportunity to assist the County with its grant research and submission process. We have had great success pairing with County staff to prepare and submit applications. Last year we assisted in acquiring over \$4 million of state and federal grant funds.

We met with Seminole County Department heads and staff to discuss the County's funding needs and projects list. We have begun researching funding opportunities and will pursue grants for these projects through the coming year. Given the weak economy, the competition for grant funding will be strong. We will pursue aggressively those funding programs that have strong promise for furthering the County's important projects and programs.

The outlook for federal grants is unclear with the new leadership in Congress. We feel confident that transportation and energy programs will receive priority in the new Congress. State grant funding will remain at lower levels until state revenues have a chance to rebound. As with the federal government, it is uncertain what changes will take place under the leadership of our new Governor.

## **Statistical Data**

The 2009/10 fiscal year presented great opportunities for Seminole County to apply for competitive grant programs. A total of 68 applications were submitted, which requested a total of \$52.7M in grant funds. Of those submitted and no longer pending, the County was awarded 40 grants totaling \$37.5M reflecting a 59% known success rate. Staff continues to monitor the 14 applications still under review.

#### American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009

Contributing towards the increase in grant activity was the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA), which was signed into law by President Barack Obama on February 17, 2009. Although the ARRA was passed in FY 2008/09, many of the funding opportunities didn't become available until the 2009/10 fiscal year. Each opportunity was carefully evaluated by the Grants Administrator, Grant Consultants, and Grants Review Team for feasibility. Those grants pursued were ones where projects closely paralleling the grant program focus and ready for implementation upon award. Applications requesting \$20.6M in competitive and entitlement grant dollars were submitted and \$17.1M was awarded. Staff continues to monitor ARRA-funded programs for any opportunities resulting from de-obligated funds.

In response to the ARRA with its stringent guidelines, an ARRA Compliance Oversight Committee was formed. This committee was comprised of representation from the County Manager's Office, the County Attorney's Office, the Fiscal Services Dept Director, the Purchasing and Contracts Division Manager, and the Grants Administrator. Working together, the committee established procedures and continues to provide general oversight of ARRA compliance.

Throughout FY 2009/10, the Grants Administrator, ARRA Compliance Oversight Committee members, and representatives of the Clerk of Court have met with staff that is responsible for managing ARRA funded grants to discuss ARRA requirements and specific compliance procedures. Each applicable department is vastly aware of the ARRA mandates and is diligent in taking necessary measures to ensure compliance. Staff is confident that Seminole County's approach to ensuring ARRA compliance will result in excellent outcomes.

## **Grants Administration Presence on SharePoint 2007**

Grants Administration has utilized SharePoint for several years for management of grant activity and electronic storage of grantrelated documents. However, with the countywide rollout of SharePoint 2007, enhancements were made to better serve internal customers. Staff can now easily view grant policies, forms, ARRA documents, and announcements; and access helpful links to grant-related websites.
