NOISE ORDINANCE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE AMENDMENT – Consider an Ordinance amending the Land Development Code to provide performance standards related to noise; (Mary Moskowitz, Project Manager) – *Recommended for Approval*

CODE ENFORCEMENT SPECIAL MAGISTRATE March 12, 2020

1. <u>2402 DAKOTA TRL</u> – Construction without the required permits. Vicki Hathaway, Inspector. Order Finding Compliance entered waiving the total fine accrued in the amount of \$1,400.00. The property was in compliance at the time of the hearing.
